

# Payroll Tax rebate scheme

For certain industries employing new apprentices and trainees ...

## About the rebate scheme

A two year rebate of payroll tax scheme has been created for businesses that employ apprentices and trainees in specific skill shortage industries from **1 July 2019** to **30 June 2021** inclusive.

The eligible industry sectors are:

- building and construction;
- tourism and hospitality; and
- manufacturing.

## How does my business apply for the new scheme?

Choose one of the following options:

### A. My business is registered for the [existing rebate scheme](#) (which is due to finish on 30 June 2019):

The State Revenue Office will contact you well before 1 July 2019 to check with you whether you're eligible for the new rebate scheme and, if so, whether you wish to carry across your existing registration.

### B. My business is not registered for the existing rebate scheme:

- i) Check the [existing rebate scheme](#) to see whether you're an eligible applicant. If you decide to register, the State Revenue Office will contact you before June 2019 asking if you wish to carry over your registration to the new scheme.  
or
- ii) [Subscribe](#) to the State Revenue Office email subscription service to receive updates and more information about the new scheme once they're available.
