

# Application for duty exemption on transfer of vehicle registration to surviving registered operator(s)

## Statutory Declaration

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### Statutory Declaration

A statutory declaration is a written statement declared to be true in the presence of an authorised person.

The following people are authorised to witness your signature on a Statutory Declaration:

- Legal practitioner;
- Registered health practitioner (doctor, nurse, pharmacist etc);
- Bank officer, credit union officer, or finance company officer with five or more years of continuous service;
- Judge or magistrate of a court;
- Police officer;
- Teacher employed full-time at a school or tertiary education institution;
- Veterinary surgeon;
- Pharmacist;
- Commissioner for Affidavits and Declarations;
- Justice of the Peace

### Who should complete this declaration

This declaration should only be completed by the surviving owner(s) / registered operators(s) where:

- one of the owners / registered operators of a vehicle is deceased; and
- the vehicle registration is to be transferred to all of the surviving owner(s) / registered operator(s).

This declaration is **not** to be completed if the vehicle registration is being transferred to a deceased person's beneficiary and the proposed transferee is not already an owner / registered operator of the vehicle.
